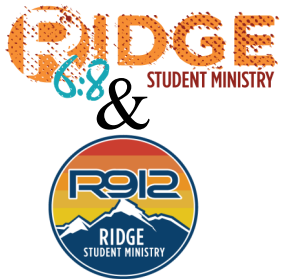
Children 1st - 5th grades will be released to Large Group in the Oasis at 10:10am or when the #60 is shown on the digital screens at the front of the Worship Center.
