

## Seven Powerful Statements from the Cross Victory

*"It is Finished"*

### **John 4: 34**

*"My food," said Jesus, "is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work.*

### **John 19: 30**

*When he had received the drink, Jesus said, "It is finished." With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.*

### **What Did Jesus Finish on the Cross?**

1. *He accomplished God's commitment.*

II Corinthians 1: 20

For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ...

2. *He fulfilled God's law.*

Romans 8: 3, 4

For what the law was powerless to do because it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending his own...<sup>4</sup>in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

3. *He paid for our sins.*

Ephesians 1: 7

In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace.

4. *He conquered the fear of death.*

Hebrews 2: 14, 15

Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil—<sup>15</sup>and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death.

5. *He defeated the devil.*

Colossians 1: 13

For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves,
